

RESTRICTIONS FROM 11.59PM THURSDAY 8 JULY

Note: Cleaning, signage, record keeping, and other COVIDSafe requirements continue to apply for all venues and facilities with onsite operations as per the Workplace Directions. The Density Quotient (DQ) applies to all venues and spaces that are accessible to the public (and in closed workplaces, to shared spaces such as lunchrooms).

Remember to always check in at every venue using the Service Vic QR Code app.

| Education and childcare | Early learning centres, childcare, kinder, family day care: Open |
| | Schools: Density quotient of 1 person per 2sqm applies, except in areas used by students |
| | Higher education and training: Density quotient of 1 person per 2sqm applies, except in areas used by students |
| Ceremonies and Religious Gatherings | Religious gatherings and ceremonies: No overarching venue limit. Density quotient of 1 person per 2 sqm applies when using a COVID Check-in Marshal, otherwise density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies |
| Funerals | Funerals (indoors and outdoors): Permitted with 300 people plus those necessary to conduct the funeral, subject to venue density limits. Children under 12 months old are not counted towards this cap |
| Weddings | Weddings (indoor and outdoor): Permitted with 300 people subject to venue density limits. Dancefloors permitted with a limit of 50 people |
