## NORTHERN REGION WORKS KEEP LINE IN TOP SHAPE

Trains have returned to the Bendigo, Swan Hill and Echuca lines following a two-week blitz of major signal and structure renewals to provide safe, comfortable and reliable services for passengers.

Acting Minister for Public Transport Jacinta Allan said more than 500 people worked around-the-clock to complete \$21 million worth of infrastructure upgrades as part of V/Line's major maintenance and renewals program.

Completed over the school holidays, the works along the Bendigo line included a \$6 million renewal of equipment which connects tracks north of Bendigo Station, a \$3 million upgrade to the track in the Elphinstone Tunnel and the replacement of more than three kilometres of rail in the Black forest.

Crews upgraded several bridges and culverts on the Swan Hill and Echuca lines, along with works on the Murray Valley Highway level crossing in Echuca. Construction also ramped up on Bendigo's new bio-wash and train monitoring facilities.

A new timetable is now in place, allowing a morning train from Eaglehawk to Southern Cross to make an additional stop at Sunbury, providing a more convenient option for Macedon Ranges students to get to school.

Throughout the past financial year, V/Line has delivered more than \$250 million in major improvement projects, as well as regular maintenance works which were mostly done at night to minimise disruption to passengers.

Other projects have included bridge and culvert upgrades on the Seymour, Shepparton, Warrnambool, Ballarat, Ararat and Maryborough lines, rail renewal on the Geelong line and the replacement of 250,000 sleepers across the network.
