BALLARAT BOOST: INVESTMENT BACKS NEW MANUFACTURING JOBS

The Victorian Government is backing manufacturing businesses in Ballarat, helping them bolster production and create new highly skilled jobs.

Minister for Regional Development Mary-Anne Thomas today toured Plinius Engineering in Canadian, one of several Ballarat companies that have purchased new equipment and hired new staff with support from the Government's *Regional Jobs Fund*.

Locally owned and operated, Plinius Engineering has been manufacturing wrought iron products since the 1950s. Innovation has enabled the business to grow and it has manufactured steel for Mars Stadium, the Ballarat Sports and Entertainment Centre and the Ballarat saleyards.

Plinius Engineering is ensuring that highly skilled manufacturing jobs stay in Ballarat. The grant from the *Regional Jobs Fund* will allow the company to install the necessary infrastructure to expand production even further.

Manufacturing jobs will also be created in Ballarat thanks to \$986 million in the *Victorian Budget 2021/22* to support the design, construction and maintenance of 25 new X-Trapolis 2.0 trains.

The new trains will provide a vital boost to the state's advanced rolling stock manufacturing industry – with at least 150 of the new jobs to be based at Alstom's Ballarat facility.

The *Regional Jobs Fund* is part of the Government's flagship *Regional Jobs and Infrastructure Fund* which helps businesses create jobs in regional Victoria, supports community projects and backs councils to build the infrastructure that locals and visitors need.

A new round of the *Regional Jobs Fund* opened earlier this year and will be available throughout 2021 to companies seeking to grow their operations.
