Special bar and dining experiences, including an alfresco pop-up restaurant in the NGV Garden surrounded by the beautiful pink aquatic art installation, *pond[er]*, will also be part of the program.

NGV Summer Nights is expected to bring tens of thousands of people into Melbourne to dine out at restaurants and stay in CBD hotels – supporting tourism and hospitality jobs across the city.
