GEELONG'S GREEN SPINE OPENS AHEAD OF CHRISTMAS

Major works in Geelong's CBD are now complete, with the Green Spine area opening to shoppers in time for Christmas, thanks to support from the Albanese and Allan Labor Governments and City of Greater Geelong.

Victorian Minister for Regional Development Gayle Tierney today announced that Block 3 of the Green Spine project – which is on the south side of Malop Street between Yarra and Bellerine streets – is open, paving the way for Christmas trade.

The Green Spine is a key project under the 10-year Revitalising Central Geelong Action Plan, creating a new pedestrian-friendly park along Malop Street with environmental and economic benefits for the CBD.

The project is being delivered over 6 blocks – with 3 of the blocks now complete.

The project is made possible by the Geelong City Deal – a collaborative partnership to transform Geelong and the Great Ocean Road funded by the Australian and Victorian governments and the City of Greater Geelong.

The completion of block 3 of the Green Spine includes new native plants, a separated bike lane on Malop Street, a raised wombat pedestrian crossing between Yarra and Bellerine streets and a refurbishment of parts of the road.

The Green Spine will make the street safer for cyclists and pedestrians while enticing shoppers to stay longer with seating and areas to have lunch.

Victorian building company Bild Infrastructure has completed the Block 3 works, while working with local businesses to minimise disruption to trading during construction.
