The Government supported Northcote Business Association with a grant of \$450,000 for the Festival in recognition of the vital benefit street festivals have for jobs, businesses and the local economy.

To further support business, the *Victorian Budget 2023/24* is investing \$17 million in multicultural traders and precincts, recognising their unique role in delivering for their businesses and communities.

This includes funding to upgrade and revitalise business and cultural hubs across our multicultural precincts and grants to peak multicultural traders' associations to ensure their members have access to the services they need.
