## PRIDE MONTH DRAG STORYTIME ON THE RAINBOW TRAM

LGBTIQA+ Victorians had an extra reason to celebrate Pride Month with a drag storytime event on board a Melbourne tram today.

Minister for Equality Harriet Shing today joined Switchboard CEO Joe Ball, drag performer Frock Hudson and a group of rainbow families for a joyful event aboard Switchboard Victoria's tram in East Melbourne.

As part of Victoria's 10-year equality strategy Pride In Our Future, the Allan Labor Government is continuing to support safe, diverse and inclusive events, and programs with and for LGBTIQA+ communities right across Victoria.

The Yarra Trams Community Partnerships Program supports Switchboard's branded tram, which focuses on connecting LGBTIQA+ communities, sharing important messages of inclusion, safety, and visibility along the busy 109 and 48 routes.
