MELBOURNE SET TO BE BEWITCHED BY BEETLEJUICE

The global phenomenon *Beetlejuice The Musical* will make its Australian premiere at Melbourne's Regent Theatre this Saturday, drawing fans from across the country to Australia's cultural capital — proudly backed by the Allan Labor Government.
