## PREMIER AG TECH EVENT RETURNS TO VICTORIA IN 2026

The 2023-24 Food and Fibre Export Performance Report, shows Victoria is Australia's top food and fibre exporter, capturing 27 per cent of the total national export value.

Victoria makes the ideal backdrop for the next edition of evoke<sup>AG</sup> as it is home to a quarter of Australia's farm businesses, 14 agricultural Research and Development centres, world-class universities, and a thriving business startup ecosystem.

Since its inception in 2019, evoke<sup>AG</sup> has brought together over 8,100 delegates, 391 investors, 577 speakers, and 1,122 primary producers to drive agriculture towards a better future.
