VICTORIA LEADING THE WAY IN HEALTHCARE INNOVATION

Victoria is at the forefront of healthcare innovation with the opening of a new research accelerator, backed by the Allan Labor Government.

Minister for Skills and TAFE Gayle Tierney today officially opened the Monash Velos Accelerator at the Monash Technology Precinct, a research hub backed by a \$17.5 million investment from the Labor Government.

Integrated with the Victorian Heart Hospital and Victorian Heart Institute, the Velos Accelerator will fast-track heart health therapies, clinical products, cardiac technology and new and innovative models of care, focusing on the connections between obesity, diabetes, chronic kidney disease and cardiovascular disease.

The facility will enable Monash University to deliver greater innovation in biotechnology, pharmaceutical and cardiovascular disease research, and develop new products and services that lead to better health outcomes for Victorians.

The centre features research and collaboration spaces for start-ups, industry and manufacturers, with access to cutting-edge equipment and technology to help drive the invention and commercialisation of new health care products and services.

Velos Accelerator will also develop training and education programs in partnership with industry leaders, to build the capability for entrepreneurship within the clinical and research workforce and deliver the health solutions our state needs sooner.

Jointly funded by the Labor Government and Monash University, the Velos Accelerator will become a world-leading, locally grounded and globally connected innovation hub, addressing some of the most pressing global health challenges.

The Labor Government has invested more than \$1 billion in medical research over the last decade, cementing Victoria as a cutting-edge leader in this field.

The Labor Government's investment in the Velos Accelerator was provided through the \$350 million Victorian Higher Education State Investment Fund, which supported universities with capital works, research infrastructure projects and applied research focused on boosting Victoria's productivity and economy.
